Synod Part II

You may be following the news that the Synod of Bishops on Synodality is currently in session until October 27th. This is the second and last session. Pope Francis has kept the focus on listening instead of policy. He wants the Synod gathering to be a model for the Church as a listening Church. He feels that if we can listen to each other we can come to a better understanding where the Holy Spirit is leading us.

I found it interesting that during one of the daily briefings the current Archbishop of Tokyo, Tarcisio Isao Kikuchi, S.V.D., said that during the listening sessions in his archdiocese at the beginning phase of the Synod some years ago, people kept on telling him to get practical, to come up with ways to move forward. He said that was like building the house without a foundation. He said that as a church our practical nature tells us to come up with plans and strategies first, but we must resist this because we need to come to a better understanding of the foundation of our faith before we come up with concrete plans. We want to get things done, but the Holy Father is seeking to slow down the construction of the house and focus more on the foundation of our faith: walking together in and through Christ Jesus.

Let us pray that the remaining weeks of the Synod will help the church to come to a deeper understanding of itself as it strives to be faithful to the gospel.

Have a wonderful week and let us continue to pray for the victims of war, hurricanes and violence.

Sínodo Parte II

Quizás estés siguiendo las noticias de que el Sínodo de los Obispos sobre la Sinodalidad está actualmente en sesión hasta el 27 de octubre. Esta es la segunda y última sesión. El Papa Francisco ha mantenido el foco en escuchar en lugar de en la política. Quiere que la reunión del Sínodo sea un modelo para la Iglesia como una Iglesia que escucha. Él siente que si podemos escucharnos unos a otros podemos llegar a una mejor comprensión de hacia dónde nos está guiando el Espíritu Santo.

Me pareció interesante que durante una de las reuniones informativas diarias, el actual arzobispo de Tokio, Tarcisio Isao Kikuchi, S.V.D., dijera que durante las sesiones de escucha en su archidiócesis en la fase inicial del Sínodo hace algunos años, la gente le seguía diciendo que fuera práctico, que encontrara formas de avanzar. Dijo que eso era como construir la casa sin cimientos. Dijo que como iglesia nuestra naturaleza práctica nos dice que primero debemos elaborar planes y estrategias, pero debemos resistirnos a esto porque necesitamos llegar a una mejor comprensión del fundamento de nuestra fe antes de elaborar planes concretos. Queremos hacer las cosas, pero el Santo Padre está tratando de frenar la construcción de la casa y centrarse más en el fundamento de nuestra fe: caminar juntos en y por medio de Cristo Jesús.

Oremos para que las semanas restantes del Sínodo ayuden a la iglesia a llegar a una comprensión más profunda de sí misma mientras se esfuerza por ser fiel al evangelio.

Que tengan una semana maravillosa y sigamos orando por las víctimas de la guerra, los huracanes y la violencia.
